



**DUAL ENROLLMENT / DUAL CREDIT FOR
HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

All dually enrolled students must complete the following to be eligible:

- Must be in grade 10, 11, or 12.
- Have a “B” average in completed high school courses.
- Meet the entrance requirements established by Southern Union.
- If your high school is an unaccredited high school, submit a minimum composite score of 16 on the ACT or composite score of 780 on the SAT.
- Submit a SU college application for general admissions.
- For placement test exemption, provide a copy of ACT or SAT results. If the student has not taken either test or did not score 20 in each section (ENG, RDG, & MTH) of the ACT or 480 in each section of the SAT, the student will need to take the COMPASS test to ensure proper placement in classes.
- Have written approval from the appropriate principal and the local superintendent of education for each semester. (Complete the following form.)
