C. Income Information

Students and parents who filed a 2015 Federal Tax Return must provide the income tax information in one of the following ways:

IRS Data Retrieval Tool – Using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) that is part of FAFSA on the Web at www.fafsa.gov is the fastest, easiest and most secure way to provide the income tax information required for verification. This option is available 2-3 weeks after your tax return has been filed. If you didn't utilize this feature when you filed the FAFSA, you may make a correction to the FAFSA and follow the steps as they appear in the financial section.

OR

2015 Tax "Return" Transcript – If you are unable or choose not to use the IRS DRT, you must provide a 2015 Tax Return Transcript, which you must request from the IRS. Go online to www.irs.gov, and under "Tools" click on "Get a tax transcript," then follow the instructions. Make sure you get the Tax **Return** Transcript and not the Tax Account Transcript. You may also order one to be mailed by calling 1-800-908-9946.
