Alabama licensure to practice fee	Included in initial AL state board exam testing above. \$50 for Georgia licensure; \$20 annual renewal	Initial license registration upon successful completion of national and state board examinations required to practice in the state of AL as a Veterinary Technician. AL license renewed on an annual basis (\$75).
Total fee estimation	\$14,967.50 (does not include pre-requisite academic coursework)	Does not include travel (gas/mileage etc) to and from class and clinical site locations (within ~75 mile radius from SUSCC Valley campus)

**Note that these are estimated costs. Costs will vary depending on previous coursework completed, health insurance policy types etc. Pricing for immunizations, blood titers, physical examinations are estimated and will vary based on health care provider. Textbook and student resource material costs can be reduced by utilizing the campus bookstore or purchasing used items through other sources (online, previous students, rental services etc.) Costs may change at any time and without notice. It is the responsibility of the student to identify exact costs.*

*** Students will receive an initial background during the application/admission process. Additional randomized drug screenings will be performed throughout the program coursework.*

Additional comments: You are required to submit proof of current health insurance prior to enrollment in VET program coursework. Proof of completed vaccination series (Rabies Pre-exposure; Tetanus) is also required.
