

NURSING PROGRAM EARLY ADMISSION

for Dual Enrollment Students

Students eligible to apply must have:

- Completed a minimum of 10 credit hours of nursing academic courses with an A or B at SUSCC
- Obtained a minimum composite score of 18 on the ACT
- Maintained a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher

| Nursing Academic Courses | Credit Hours |

| MTH 100: Intermediate College Algebra (or higher level) | 3 |
| ENG 101: English Composition I | 3 |
| PSY 210: Human Growth & Development | 3 |
| SPH 107: Public Speaking (or SPH 106) | 3 |
| BIO 201: Human Anatomy & Physiology I | 4 |
| BIO 202: Human Anatomy & Physiology II | 4 |

Program Admission:

- Apply for Nursing Program Early Admission upon completion of the 11th-grade year
- Meeting minimal eligibility requirements does not guarantee acceptance
- Space is limited and applicants will be selected based on academic achievement
- Dual enrollment scholarships may be available upon acceptance into the program

Once accepted, Nursing Program Early Admission students must:

- Complete any of the remaining nursing academic credit hours listed above maintaining a B or higher before or concurrent with high school graduation
- Maintain good standing with the college
- Attend the mandatory Nursing Program Orientation (July) following high school graduation
- Start the SUSCC Nursing Program the fall semester (August) following high school graduation
