OVERVIEW

The purpose of the Medical Assistant
Technology (MAT) program is to prepare
competent, entry-level medical assistants in
the cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor
(skills), and affective (behavior) learning
domains so that they may enter the profession
and assist the provider in providing patient
care in providers' offices, minor emergency
centers, long-term care facilities, and other
types of ambulatory healthcare facilities.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the general admission requirements of the College, applicants to the Medical Assistant Technology program must meet the following criteria:

- College Admission. Applicants must be unconditionally admitted to SUSCC.
 - Current or former SUSCC students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
 - Transfer students must be admitted to SUSCC with a clear academic status and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Transcripts. Official transcripts must be received in the Records Office from high school and all post-secondary institutions attended prior to applying.
- Placement Requirements. Applicants must demonstrate eligibility for English 101, eligibility for Math 100, and satisfy SUSCC's reading requirement.
- Test Score Requirement. Applicants must satisfy one of the following options:
 - Option One: Minimum composite score of 18 on the ACT National or ACT Residual. No superscores will be accepted.
 - Option Two: Earning a minimum of silver level on the ACT WorkKeys exam.
- Submission of completed application for the MAT Program before the established deadline.
