Southern Union State Community College Manufacturing Production Technician Program

The Manufacturing Production Technician Program is a non-credit 180-hour program for the College. Individuals may enter the program without a high school diploma or GED; however, Southern Union as well as the credentialing agency strongly recommends that individuals enrolling in this program perform at a 9th-grade math and 10th-grade reading level as well as possess basic computer skills before enrolling in the Manufacturing Production Technician training program.

The Manufacturing Production Technician Program consists of four sessions: Safety, Quality Practices & Measurement, Manufacturing Processes & Production, and Maintenance Awareness. Candidates must pass all four sessions to receive the Manufacturing Skill Standards Council (MSSC), Certified Production Technician (CPT) Certification.
