NOTE: A total of twelve (12) additional points are earned by applicants who have completed applicable veterinary related observation or working hours AND have completed the "Southern Union Veterinary Technology Program Observation Form". This form must be received along with application materials. Forms must be completed, signed and dated by a currently licensed Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM), or Licensed Veterinary Technician (LVT) employed by the facility at which hours were completed. Points are calculated based on the following scale: 8-16 hours of veterinary observation or work experience = 3 points; 17-20 hours of veterinary observation or work experience = 6 points; 21-39 hours of veterinary observation experience = 9 points; 41 or more hours of veterinary observation or work experience = 12 points
